Who We Are:

We are part of a national network of 28 Estuarine Research Reserves. GBNERR promotes long-term research, education and stewardship throughout the Great Bay Estuary.

Intern Tasks & Minimum Requirements:

- Lead spring school programs, 1-2 mornings per week (Mon and/or Tues preferred).
- Assist staff with summer programs and lead several planned programs.
- Develop and lead a new, weekly, summer program, within GBNERRs mission.
- Must be a junior or senior in an undergrad program or in a master's program, pursuing a natural resources/environmental or education degree.

Schedule:

- Spring training April 12th, 9:30-4 is recommended.
- 4-8 hours per week mid-April through mid-June, teaching school programs.
- 16 hours per week mid-June through August:
 - o 8 hours on Wednesdays assisting with summer camp for ages 6-11.
 - o 4 hours on Thursday mornings assisting with general education programs.
 - o 4 hours on Friday mornings running the program that you have developed.

Benefits:

- Work with a great staff and spend time outside.
- Gain valuable teaching and curriculum development experience.
- Staff will work with you to ensure any internship requirements outlined by your college are met.
- Letters of recommendation from staff at your request.
