

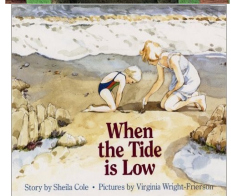
# Once Upon a Summer Estuary 2017 for ages 2-5

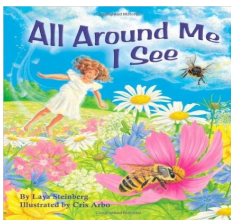
Thursday July 6th "Welcome Home Bear:" by Il Sung Na

Do you know why a bear's home is different than a snake's? Join us as we learn about different animals and the places they call home. Then make a craft to take home to yours!



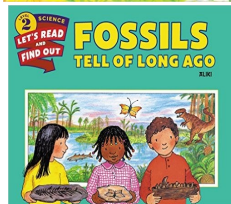
Thursday July 13th "When the Tide is Low" by Sheila Cole

Do you know who lives on the mudflats of Great Bay? Come explore with us as we catch some critters and have fun getting a little muddy!



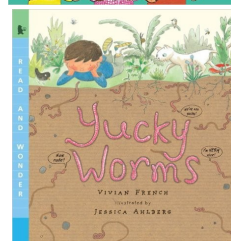
Thursday July 20th "All Around Me I See" by Laya Steinberg

Come learn about fossils and how they're made. We'll turn you into fossil hunters as you dig for treasures and make a fossil to take home.



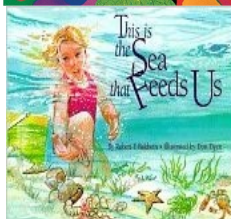
Thursday August 3rd "Yucky Worms" by Vivian French
