- Help steward conservation land throughout the Great Bay region-marking property boundaries, maintaining trails, and more.
- Work with Stewardship staff at Great Bay's Community Wildlife Garden.
- Other field tasks as needed.
- We will teach you all necessary skills.
- Requirements:
  - Must be comfortable working outdoors, in the woods, for long periods of time, in varying weather conditions.
  - Must be able to lift 40 pounds.
  - Good hiking boots and field clothes are a must.
  - The most important thing is to have a love of working outdoors!

### Schedule:

- Tuesdays and Wednesdays late-May through August, 14-16 hours per week.

- Work with a great staff and spend a lot of time outside.
- Learn new field skills and gain valuable experience.
- Staff will work with you to ensure any college internship requirements are met.
